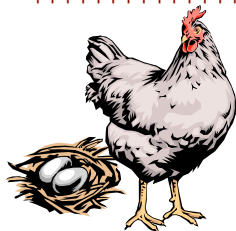

Treasurer's Report - Dave Klenske

We have wrapped up 2006 and are focused on making 2007 the best ever for the Belwood Homeowners Association. The Belwood Dolphins will have had their sign-ups by the time you read this, and winter should be just about over. Be sure to plan your summer parties at the cabana early-space fills up quickly!

I am pleased to report that we ended 2006 with \$2.8K income vs. a projected budget loss of over \$13K. As I mentioned in the previous report, key areas of savings on the expense side were payroll, worker's comp, and utility bills. Our balance sheet remains fine with about \$62K of assets which include \$30K for reserves. Both of these statements are shown below. The dues increase for 2007 will go into the reserve fund, so we can have the funds to pay for future maintenance and capital expenditures. You should have already received your annual bill, and your prompt payment is appreciated.

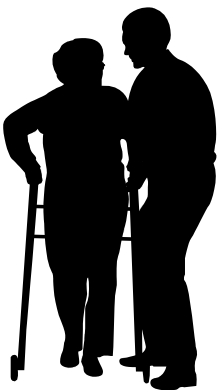
