# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE by John Bills

The pool is open with a whole new look. The 2011 Lifeguard staff is in place and the pool is open every day from 1:00pm – 7:00pm. **Key holders, please remember that outside of the normal Lifeguard hours, do not prop the gate open to the pool.** We really need everyone's help with this. While this makes it more convenient to come and go from the pool area, it creates a *huge* safety hazard for children who may be at the cabana for an event and who could wander into the pool area unsupervised. **Please ensure that the gate is firmly closed as you enter and exit the pool area outside of Lifeguard hours.** To ensure that we all have a safe summer, please review the Cabana rules on our website at www.belwoodhomes.org.

Mosquitos: After all the rain, there are places in our yards where small pools may have accumulated providing ideal breeding grounds for mosquitos. Please take a few minutes to walk through your yard and eliminate these dens. Common places: empty flower pots, children's toys, wheelbarrows, fountains, wishing wells, gutters from clogged down spouts, empty paint cans, tarps, garbage cans, uncle Karl's hooch jug, open and/or upside down things that can hold water for a long time. Please dry it up!

<u>Slow Down and Look</u>: Now that school is out, kids and young adults will be out and about in the neighborhood more frequently, in larger numbers, and perhaps with less

supervision. You may notice Belwood swimmers heading to morning practices on bikes and boards (swimmers practice from 7am-10:15am so there will be more kids on the streets during these hours as they travel to/from the pool). Please consider pouring a cup of decaf over the triple shot dose before leaving for your day. Please proceed slowly and be watchful. This will help to keep our neighborhood kids safe!

**Internet at the Pool:** The Cabana now has FREE wireless. When you are down there, ours is the BHOA connection. No login is required and the connection is UNsecure. Terms of use are simple: connection and uptime are not guaranteed and use is at your own risk. The Board has directed the Guard Staff to decline assistance with connection issues while on duty. At best, they can reboot the router during adult swim.

As a friendly reminder, this is a volunteer organization and your help is needed for projects and events that are hosted by the Association (July 4<sup>th</sup> party, Bingo/Movie nights, Halloween, etc.). # DON'T LET THE CITY CUT OUR CROSSING GUARD By Josh Lamour

As the City of San Jose deals with a \$150 million dollar deficit, many options to reduce spending are being evaluated. One item on the chopping block is our beloved crossing quard, Dorothy, at Harwood and Blossom Hill Rd. Dorothy has been providing safe passage across the busy intersection for almost a quarter century—24 years to be exact! If you've crossed this street with Dorothy, you'll know that she gives all kids a high-five, is genuinely interested in the kids' lives, and is a community fixture.

After a lot of back and forth with government officials, the SJPD, and other community individuals, it is clear that the crossing guard post at Harwood and Blossom Hill is important to a lot of people. There have been rumors about outsourcing the guards to a Southern California company that specializes in staffing crossing guards, or cutting the guard post completely. Some have inquired with the Los Gatos City Government and it has been made clear that the intersection of Harwood and Blossom Hill Rd is San Jose's authority (LG is only one of 4 corners).

### TREASURER'S REPORT by Dave Klenske

We're midway through the year and our operating budget is on track. Most of the members have paid their dues, with only about 14 as of May 15 being delinquent out of 285 members. This is normal for this time of year. Other expenses are more or less similar to last year.

I hope you've all had a chance to see the new pool deck and major renovations to the facility. With swim team starting, I'm really excited to see the new streamlined layout. It will really make the Saturdays much more enjoyable! We've also added a number of new chairs, purchased used from Courtside club. We spent about as much for 12 chairs as we'd spend for one, and these are barely used. It's another great example of the board's effective management of our funds to maximize the benefits to our members.

As mentioned in the December Belringer, my 2011 financial goals (along with current status) are:

Making sure the Cabana pool deck replacement project stays within budget Some unexpected late expenses pushed us over our budget. However, the net result for our members is a higher quality facility and less expenses down the road. Our reserve funds were adequate to cover the extra expenses.

Satisfactory completion of the audit and assurance of our financial controls. This is in process. I have been working closely with our new accountant who will also do our auditing to answer any and all questions and make sure that we are on the right track. I expect this to be completed in June. If any member would like to see a copy of it, I will gladly provide a PDF once it is finalized.

#### Getting the Belwood website back to an active state

This is completed. We will be regularly maintaining it and posting important information such as the Belringer, Key dates (such as Bingo Night), forms that you may need, etc. Please check it out and let us know what else you'd like to see on it. The URL is: http://www.belwoodhomes.org.

The most common theme coming back from the officials is that nothing is certain...yet! Guard posts around San Jose will be cut, guards will be reassigned, but I have been informed that no change will happen at our intersection until Jan. 2012. Our beloved quard Dorothy will continue to offer safe haven to the families making the trek across the Harwood and Blossom Hill Rd...at least for now.

So, what can you do? If your child uses the crossing at the intersections of Harwood and Blossom Hill Rd, I urge you to write to the local government officials and let them know that the community of Belwood needs a sanctioned crossing quard to assist in shepherding our youth across a very busy street. It should not be an option to cut such an important safety feature from our children's daily lives.
